OneVision Adds XPS Capabilities to Asura and Solvero Prepress Workflow Software: New Features to be showcased at Vienna IfraExpo October 8-11

Specifically, the new versions of Asura and Solvero are able to convert XPS files into PDF, PostScript or EPS files. The required conversion into the requested file format for the RIP can either be done automatically with Asura or Asura Pro or manually with Solvero. Users also benefit

from the “downward compatibility” in OneVision’s software solutions. For example, XPS files can now also be converted into PostScript Level 1 or PDF 1.2. With Solvero, text, images and graphics of XPS files can be edited in the same way as PDF, PostScript or EPS files.
